







Interior of Church

St. Joseph Catholic Church

For 80 years, the first St. Joseph
Catholic Church served as the center
of the Catholic Community in
Monticello. Jose Prudenzio Gonzales
and other residents from the area
raised the funds to complete this first
permanent Catholic Church building
in Southeastern Utah. The church
was dedicated by Bishop James E.
Kearney on October 9, 1935, three
years before St. Joseph was declared
a parish in 1938 and a resident priest,


Father John A. Sanders, was appointed pastor. Since that time many priests, permanent deacons, religious sisters and dedicated laity have worked to keep the Catholic faith alive in this part of Utah. After 80 years, this first church building became too small to meet the needs of the Catholic Community, and a generous Catholic family--Allen and Kathy Lund--donated money for the building of a new church adjacent to the first church. The new St. Joseph Church will be dedicated by Bishop John Wester on September 13, 2015--80 years after the first dedication.
