On Sunday February 2nd we will celebrate The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. As a reminder the Roman Missal calls for the blessing of the candles before the Mass, with either a procession or solemn entrance occurring

after the blessing. The faithful should be encouraged to bring candles to be blessed at the Mass. A parish can distribute candles to those in attendance, and the candles intended for the use of the church throughout the year might also be blessed at Masses on this day.
