Days of Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and
abstinence. Catholics 14 years and older
are asked to abstain from eating meat on
that day which includes chicken, pork,
beef, etc. and anything made from meat
including soup stock. All Fridays of
Lent are also days of abstinence from
eating meat. This means that people
should limit the size of their meals and
refrain from eating between meals.
