**National Vocation Awareness Week**

**November 5 – 11**

Matthew 9: 36-38 – At the sight of the crowds, Jesus' heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned like sheep without a shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, the harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few, so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for this harvest.

During Vocation Awareness Week our prayer intentions are all for those young men and women who felt the call to the priesthood and religious life and who have respond generously to God's invitation to serve Him and work for His vineyard.

The word vocation comes from Latin Vocare meaning to call. It is God who calls people to serve Him. There are two kinds of vocations:

1. Religious – Priesthood, brothers and nuns.
2. Secular - Different professions like doctors, engineers, etc. It also includes the vocation to married life.

What the Church needs now is the religious who will work for the furtherance of God's kingdom here on earth. Those who will commit their entire life to God and his church. Our vocation

director for the diocese of Salt Lake is Father Joseph Delka and his assistant is Fr. Dominic Sternhagen.

Our diocese has six seminarians studying for the priesthood, one of them was ordained a deacon, and next year he will be ordained a priest.
