Welcome Bishop Oscar Solis: As most of you know, we now have a new bishop for the Diocese of Salt Lake City after waiting for more than a year and a half. Our new bishop is Bishop Oscar Solis, who is currently serving as an auxiliary bishop in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. Bishop Solis was ordained a priest in 1984. In 2004 he was ordained as an auxiliary bishop for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. He was born in 1953 in San Jose in the Philippines and entered high school seminary. After ordination to the priesthood he became rector of a seminary in the Philippines before immigrating to the United States where he served in New Jersey and in Louisiana. He was pastor of St. Joseph Cathedral in Thibodaux, LA before becoming an auxiliary bishop in California where he served in the San Pedro area of the Archdiocese. Bishop Solis will be installed as the 10th Bishop of Salt Lake on Tuesday, March 7.

Installation vs Ordination: On March 7th at 2 p.m., Bishop Oscar Solis will be installed as the tenth bishop of the Diocese of Salt Lake City. Some have asked about the difference between an ordination and an installation. When a bishop is already ordained a bishop and transferred to another diocese, he is installed as bishop of the new diocese since he is already ordained a bishop. When a man is a priest and becomes a new bishop, then he is ordained as a bishop

following an ordination rite.
