**Stay Informed:** There are many ways parishioners can stay informed about upcoming events and plans in our Parish. The newly designed **web page** includes everything from current bulletins, ministry schedules. Parish Council minutes and a calendar of upcoming events. The Parish also has a Facebook page and once you indicate that you "like" the page you will receive pertinent information about the Parish. And finally, every week the **bulletin** publishes all pertinent information that parishioners need to know. Those who complain because they were not informed about things happening in the Parish are not reading the bulletin or taking advantage of the other sources of Parish news and information.

Mass Time Change: The Parish Council agreed to table the changing of the Sunday Mass from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. The Parishioners of St. Joseph Parish are not ready to begin a parish social or adult education program on Sundays after Mass. When the new Pastor comes in August, he can revisit the issue with the parishioners of both St. Pius X Parish and St. Joseph Parish in Monticello.

La Sal Mission Improvements: The Parish Council agreed to purchase gravel for the Mission parking lot to eliminate some of the issues created by the muddy conditions. They also agreed to purchase new screens for the windows of the Mission. When the gravel arrives this spring we will be looking for volunteers from the Parish to spend a Saturday morning spreading it around the parking lot.

<u>Upcoming Events in the Parish:</u> There are many upcoming events in the Parish that need volunteers to help coordinate and plan the event. Parish Council members have agreed to coordinate each event.

April Classic Car Show Parking: This event is held the last Saturday of April and is a fundraiser for the Parish that brings in about \$1500. See Marian Delay if you would like to help with its planning and coordination.

<u>Sunday Parish Socials</u>: More people are going to be invited to volunteer to host Sunday Parish Socials. <u>Deb Slechta</u> will be coordinating the effort to get more volunteers and train people in hosting a social event.

<u>Parish Picnic</u>: This year the Council will host the Parish Picnic on the first Sunday in June (*June 4*) in the park across from the Church. See <u>Chris Wilkowske</u> if you would be willing to help with the planning and execution of this year's picnic on June 4.
