afternoons or by appointment.

Lent. This includes chicken, pork, beef, etc. and anything made from meat including soup stock.

Stations of the Cross: This year we are going to have Stations of the Cross at 6:00 p.m. (immediately following the 5:30 p.m. Mass) on the Mondays of Lent rather than on Fridays of Lent. (The Church will be open on Fridays for anyone who would like to do a private devotional praying of the Stations until 6:00 p.m.)

Fridays During Lent: Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. on the Fridays of Lent. (There will be no Mass, Stations of the Cross or Benediction celebrated.) This will be an opportunity for you to celebrate Stations privately, pray a rosary or have some quiet prayer

Easter Flower Donations: If you would like to make a donation for this year's Easter Flowers, the envelopes are on the back tables of the Church. If you would like your loved one's name printed in the Easter bulletin and remembered at the Easter Sunday Mass, write the name(s) clearly on the donation envelope and put it in with the regular collection. (We ask that your donation be at least \$5 if you would like

the name printed in the bulletin in memoriam of a loved one.)

New Assignment for Fr. Bill: As you know. Fr. Bill informed the Diocese in December that this would be his last vear as Pastor of St. Pius Church & St. Joseph Parish in Monticello after serving here for eight years. While I had many options to consider including retirement to Alaska, the Bishop and Diocesan Personnel Board asked me to become Pastor of my home parish in Ogden, Utah to replace the current pastor who is retiring. Because of the priest shortage in the Diocese, I agreed to become Pastor of Holy Family Catholic Church in Ogden. While Alaska was a tempting possibility, this will give me a chance to work as a priest in both the elementary and high schools that I attended as well as with many friends from my life before I became a priest. I am very excited about returning to my hometown for a few years before finally retiring. The new assignment will begin on August 1st. (To date, no replacement pastor has been named for the parishes and missions of Southeastern Utah.)

Welcome, Bishop Oscar Solis: Our new Bishop of Salt Lake City was installed as the 10th Bishop of the Diocese last Tuesday in a beautiful ceremony. The Mass and installation will be re-broadcast on EWTN this Tuesday at 1:00 p.m.
