--Daily Mass Schedule Change:

Mass will be celebrated at 8:30 a.m. on Monday, March 20. There will be no Mass on Monday evening at 5:30 p.m. this week.

--Stations of the Cross: There will be no Stations of the Cross this Monday evening at 6:00 p.m. Praying of the Stations will resume next Monday.

--Eucharistic Holy Hour: There will be no Eucharistic Holy Hour this Friday from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m. The Holy Hour will resume next Friday evening, March 31.

Pastor Change for St. Pius X: Fr. Bill has agreed to become Pastor of Holy Family Catholic Church in Ogden beginning on August 1st. Ogden is Fr. Days of Abstinence: Catholics who are 14 years and older are asked to abstain

from eating meat on the Fridays during Lent. This includes chicken, pork, beef, etc. and anything made from meat including soup stock.
