New Pastor Named to St. Pius X: A new pastor has been named to succeed Fr. Bill as Pastor of St. Pius X and St. Joseph Parishes effective on August 1, 2017. The new Pastor is Rev. Roland Nwokocha. Fr. Roland is from Nigeria, Africa and has been in the Diocese of Salt Lake City for several years. He has been in residence at St. Ambrose Parish in Salt Lake City and providing hospital ministry to University Hospital and several other Salt Lake area hospitals. Fr. Roland hopes to make several visits to Moab before the change to meet with the Parish Council and some of the parishioners. (Fr.
