New Pastor Named to St. Pius X:

A new pastor has been named to succeed Fr. Bill as Pastor of St. Pius X and St. Joseph Parishes effective on August 1, 2017. The new Pastor is Rev. Roland Nwokocha. Fr. Roland is from Nigeria, Africa and has been in the Diocese of Salt Lake City for several years. He has been in residence at St. Ambrose Parish in Salt Lake City and providing hospital ministry to University Hospital and several other Salt Lake area hospitals.

Eucharistic Holy Hour: On the **Fridays of Lent, from 5 to 6:00 p.m.,** the Holy Eucharist will be exposed on the altar for quiet prayer and devotion. *(There will be no communal Stations, Mass or*

Benediction on those days.)

Stations of the Cross: The communal praying of the Stations of the Cross will be at **6:00 p.m. this Monday.** *(Stations will also be celebrated on the Monday of Holy Week.)*
