Parish Lighting Project: In a couple of weeks we will be doing some major renovation in the Church as we remove the florescent lighting and replace it with new track lighting and pendant lights. The project will enhance the beauty of the Church and provide a more conducive light for worship. The project was approved by the Diocesan Arts and Environment Committee, by the Diocesan Vicar General and by the St. Pius Parish Council. The cost of the project will be \$23,000 for the new fixtures and electrical work. While we have money in savings to cover the project, several parishioners have asked for the opportunity to donate to the project. We will, therefore, have a special collection to raise money for this project next weekend, June 11th. All the money raised will go toward this project and the balance will be paid out of savings. To date, more than \$1000 has already been contributed in support of this important renovation of the Church.
