Daily Mass Change: Mass will be celebrated at 8:30 a.m. on Monday. There will be no daily Masses celebrated on Tuesday or Wednesday.

Special Collection This Weekend: A special collection will be taken up this week to show solidarity with the developing Church in Africa. The money from this collection supports Catholic missionary work, the training of priests and religious sisters and the building of Catholic Churches on the African continent. The African Catholic Church is one of the fastest growing in the world and many African priests are now serving in diocese throughout the United States experiencing a critical clergy shortage. Envelopes for this collection will be in the pews and anyone wishing to contribute to this collection can put their envelope in with the regular Sunday collection.

Pastoral Change: The new pastoral administrator of St. Pius and St. Joseph Parishes, Father Rowland Nwokocha, will arrive in Moab after August 3rd and will be here to celebrate his first Masses in the Parishes on August 5th and 6th. Father Rowland is from Nigeria and is currently serving as a hospital chaplain for the University of Utah medical center in Salt Lake City. *(Father Bill Wheaton, who has been Pastor at St. Pius Church for eight*

years, will become Pastor of Holy Family Catholic Church in Ogden, UT.)

Farewell Sunday Social: There will be a farewell Sunday Social to say goodbye to Fr. Bill after the 9:00 a.m. Mass next Sunday on July 30. Father Bill has served as Pastor of St. Pius and the Missions of Southeastern Utah for eight years and has been transferred to his home parish in Ogden.

Catholic Lagoon Day: The Annual Catholic Day, sponsored by the Knights of Columbus/Council 602, will be held at Lagoon Amusement Park in Farmington, UT (about 15 miles north of Salt Lake City) on Sunday, August 20. There will be a full day of activities offered beginning at 11:00 a.m. An outdoor Mass will be celebrated at 12 noon. There will be games, food and prizes. There is a discounted Single Day Passport available for participating Catholic for \$37.00 which permits entry to all rides and attractions. This is available at the ticket window by telling them you are there for Catholic Day.

Dedication of St. Joseph Church: The dedication of the new St. Joseph Catholic Church in Monticello will be celebrated on Wednesday, September 27, at 7:00 p.m. Bishop Oscar Solis, the Bishop of Salt Lake, will be coming to Monticello for the dedication. While parishioners from St. Pius are welcome to attend and no special tickets will be required, space will be limited and reserved seating will only be available for special invited guests.
