Policy regarding distribution of “The Cup” and the “kiss of Peace” during influenza outbreaks

When there is a serious influenza outbreak or similar occasion, the

pastor/administrator of each parish or mission, at his discretion, may suspend the distribution of Holy Communion under the species of the sacred Blood. Pastors and administrators may also modify or eliminate the ritual “kiss of Peace” before Holy Communion so that congregants bow to one another rather than embrace or shake hands.

Ash Wednesday This Week:

This Wednesday marks the beginning of the Lenten season- the forty days of fasting, prayer and deeds of loving service that prepare us for Easter.

Days of Fast and Abstinence: Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence, Catholics 14 years and older are asked to abstain from eating meat on that day which includes chicken, pork, beef, etc., and anything made from meat including soup stock. All Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence from eating meat. Ash Wednesday is also a day of fasting for adult Catholics.

Stations of the Cross. Fridays of Lent we shall have Stations of the Cross at the church at 6pm.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament:
The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration on Fridays 1 pm - 5 pm.
