**Policy regarding distribution of “The  
Cup” and the “kiss of Peace” during  
influenza outbreaks**

When there is a serious influenza outbreak or similar occasion, the pastor/administrator of each parish or mission, at his discretion, may suspend the distribution of Holy Communion under the species of the sacred Blood. Pastors and administrators may also modify or eliminate the ritual “kiss of peace” before Holy Communion so that congregants bow to one another rather than embrace or shake hands.
