Bishop Solis has asked that all priests, particularly pastors and administrators, be encouraged to take up a special “Emergency Collection for 2018 Natural Disasters” anytime during November 2018.

This is especially in light of Hurricane Florence, the earthquake and tsunami in Indonesia, and Hurricane Michael (please see the attached from the “President of US Bishops Conference Announcement on Emergency Collection for 2018 Natural Disasters”). This attached notification from the USCCB could be included in the recommendation.

Again, this collection is encouraged, but optional. All moneys will be sent to Catholic Relief Services, but would be in addition to the regular collection we take up each year for CRS.
