**Ash Wednesday Masses**

**Days of Fast and Abstinence**

**Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and**

**abstinence.** Catholics 14 years and older are asked to abstain from eating meat on that day which includes chicken, pork, beef, etc. and anything made from meat including soup stock.

**All Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence from eating meat.** Ash Wednesday is also a day of fasting for adult Catholics. This means that people should limit the size of their meals and refrain from eating between meals.

**Lenten Confession**

This year there will be no communal penance service during the Lenten season. On the Weekend of 3/9 we shall

have a visiting priest to hear confessions.

**Fridays During Lent:**

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. on Fridays of Lent beginning this Friday. (This will be an opportunity for you to celebrate Stations privately, pray the rosary or have a common prayer.)

**Stations of the Cross:**

This year we are going to have Stations of the Cross at 6:00 p.m. (*The Church will be open on Fridays for anyone who would like to do a private devotional praying of the Stations.*)

**Operation Rice Bowl**
