Ash Wednesday Masses

Mass will be celebrated at St. Pius Church at 7:00 p.m. on Ash Wednesday, March 6th.

Mass will also be celebrated at St. Joseph Church in Monticello on Ash Wednesday at 4:30 p.m.

Days of Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence. Catholics 14 years and older are asked to abstain from eating meat on that day which includes chicken, pork, beef, etc. and anything made from meat including soup stock.

All Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence from eating meat. Ash Wednesday is also a day of fasting for adult Catholics. This means that people should limit the size of their meals and refrain from eating between meals.

Lenten Confession

This year there will be no communal penance service during the Lenten season. On the Weekend of 3/9 we shall have a visiting priest to hear confessions.

Fridays During Lent:

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. on Fridays of Lent beginning this Friday. (This will be an opportunity for you to celebrate Stations privately, pray the rosary or have a common prayer.)

Stations of the Cross:

This year we are going to have Stations of the Cross at 6:00 p.m. (*The Church will be* open on Fridays for anyone who would like to do a private devotional praying of the Stations.)
